Bifurcation Bonanza for Seemandhra

A massive bonanza awaits Seemandhra region, after the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh State to facilitate formation of Telangana State which in all likelihood shall be completed by the end of this year. The draft notes prepared by the union home ministry on the package to be offered by different ministries at the Centre speak of a huge economic windfall for each of the 13 districts of residuary State of Andhra Pradesh. Contrary to political criticism that congress is neglecting Seemandhra, the Congress president Sonia Gandhi is keen to ensure that a huge development package is provided to residuary State of Andhra Pradesh which has two regions of coastal Andhra and Rayalaseema; each having its distinct advantage and disadvantage.

The information that is emerging from New Delhi reveals that the congress led Central government is keen to derive massive political advantage more in Seemandhra than in proposed Telangana State. According to reliable information the economic package being dished out to Seemandhra State are not one or two but many. Starting from core infrastructure projects like –a Greenfield International Airport at Vijayawada, Zonal headquarters for South Eastern Railways at Vizag,

In turning Seemandhra into a modern destination for higher educational needs, an Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) at Guntur, an Indian Institute of Management (IIM) at Visakhapatnam and a central university of Mines and Geology at Kurnool. Besides two All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIMS) level super-specialty hospitals at Kurnool and Kakinada are some of the initiatives from the union human resources development (HRD) ministry. So far, the HRD ministry has not granted this bigger package to any state anytime in the country. Of

course, the ministry is currently headed by junior-most cabinet minister MM Pallam Raju who is actively participating in the agitation to keep Andhra Pradesh united. But, this package shows that he is secretly behind its drafting and that he secretly desires formation of a Seemandhra state although he has been sulking publicly. That's not bad politics for someone whose sole survival is dependent on the mercy of the Gandhi family.

The union ministry gathered a lot of information and inputs from different ministries in the Centre on how to transform the newly formed Seemandhra State into a viable and progressive State. Of course, the residuary state will also be called State of Andhra Pradesh, after the formation of Telangana State. So, the Seemandhra people need not worry that there won't be Andhra Pradesh in future.

It will be there, sans Telangana comprising of ten districts including Hyderabad. The Group of Ministers (GoM) formed by the Centre to oversee the division of the State has also received proposals to lay a top class eight lane express highway between Ichhapuram in Srikakulam district of the north-coastal Andhra region to Tada in Nellore district in the southern most point that is very close to Chennai, connecting the entire coastal belt for better transport and road link. The national highways ministry has prepared a report on this after studying the Golden quadrilateral National Highways project that connecting Kolkatta with Chennai covering important towns like Vizag, Kakinada, Vijayawada, Guntur, Tenali, Ongole, Nellore and Gudur in Coastal Andhra.

The GoM has also got a high end proposal to construct a Metro Rail project

in Visakhapatnam and another one connecting three cities of Vijayawada – Guntur – Tenali. Another special railway line connecting Vijayawada-Guntur to Kurnool on the lines of a similar project that connects Thiruvananthapuram and Kochi in Kerala is also being studied by the ministry of Railways. While the Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC) will be executing the Kerala project at a modest cost of Rs 10,000 crore—the same for the Seemandhra Metro Rail project is estimated to cost about Rs 15,000 crore. Another ambitious project is the exclusive Railway line between Vizag- Vijayawada-Kadapa- Anantapur- Bangalore.

If this rail road that connects the entire stretch of coastal belt and passes thru the Seema districts to connect Bengaluru; the whole Seemandhra state will be unparalleled in the country in economic development and logistics. The railway lines from Visakhapatnam to Chennai are already very much in existence. It would also kick-start the economic activity as lot of infrastructure firms will get business at their choicest places in whole of coastal Andhra and Rayalaseema districts. The entire stretch of new railway lines in the backward districts of Seemandhra will develop into a massive commercial enterprise as they facilitate numerous industrial establishments to come up. The GoM draft note says that the new international airport at Vijayawada will not be inferior to the present international airport at Shamshabad in Hyderabad. They also say that this new airport will attract flights from eastern countries like Japan, Singapore, Malaysia and Thailand. This will open huge opportunities to the region as three world class sea ports are already available over the sea-coastal of Andhra.

The union home ministry is equally concerned about the development and prosperity of Seemandhra people who still desire to remain in Hyderabad despite massive development envisaged for Seemandhra state people.

In view of this, the centre desires to ensure full facilities to the Seemandhra people in Hyderabad and proposes to expand the existing express national highway with two more lanes and run more special trains and bus services between the two regions. In addition to these, the Centre is also going to grant an agricultural research institute, a mining and geology research institute and a rural development university to the Seemandhra. These institutes are intended to cater to the needs of people over there keeping in view the agriculturally rich Godavari districts and mines rich Rayala Seema districts.

Already, the Congress Working Committee resolution has demanded the Central government to declare Polavaram dam as national project so that around 85 per cent of the total cost would be borne by the Centre. This will ease burden on the newly formed Seemandhra government and immensely benefit its people. The Centre came forward to fund the construction of a brand new capital for the Seemandhra state. Once the identification of a site for this is done by the new government of the Seemandhra, the central government can immediately begin planning and execution of work. Though

service and they can retire here peacefully. Even students too can study here for the next 10 years as locals and all benefits like scholarships would be extended to them. The law and order powers on Hyderabad city would be entrusted with the Governor of Telangana State for ten years and any attempts to threaten, or force them leave or to sell away their lands would be dealt seriously. A high level board will be set up with the CMs of two regions to see that no injustice is done to Seemandhra.

The package and safeguards offered to Seemandhra are more than enough. In fact, several Telangana activists are not happy with the range of sops being extended to Seemandhra. If all these benefits are granted to Seemandhra, the region will become another developed country like Singapore or Malaysia. Within 10 years their capital city will surpass not just Hyderabad but cities like Chennai and Bangalore. The two cities highly inhabi-

tated by Andhras since decades will face stiff competition from new capital that is going to be built in the heart of Seemandhra.

Still Playing Games:

However, some Seemandhra leaders are not content with this sort of bonanza being planned by congress led central government. They are still indulging in dirty politics trying to stop Telangana just because of their huge interests in Hyderabad's real estate. As a last ditch attempt, they have managed to manipulate the report of Antony committee report which suggested making Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation limits as the common capital for both the states and vest the law and order maintenance powers in the centre. It must be specifically mentioned that the biggest fears of many politicians from Seemandhra is their potential loss of highly valuable lands ille-

gally and inappropriately occupied by them. Already, many real estate big wigs that have made a mockery of Land laws like Protected Tenancy are making hectic attempts to get favorable orders from the Courts by hook or crook methods so that some form of compromise can be effected in due course without facing adverse political weather.

Deputy CM Damodar Rajanarsimha understandably walked out of the Congress state level coordination committee meeting held in Delhi on Friday night. Damodar remarked that: "There is no use to have Telangana, if these recommendations are implemented". It is learnt that union minister JD Seelam and other Seemandhra leaders had influenced Antony to give such a report. All the three leaders – CM Kiran Kumar Reddy, YSR Congress president Jagan Mohan Reddy and TDP president Chandrababu Naidu – desperately trying to stop or at least delay Telan-

gana till the next general elections. Jagan and Chandrababu Naidu are also trying to influence BJP leaders not to support the Telangana Bill. That is why they are acting as though they would back BJP. But, one thing is clear, that Congress president Sonia Gandhi is very firm on formation of Telangana State by her next birthday, December 9. Despite her best efforts if Telangana State is not becoming a reality in the winter session then God alone knows how peace can be ensured in the state that is already on the brink of economic crisis and if things are dragged on unreasonably; people of both regions have to fight a bitter civil war that will hurt mother India so badly-something which even enemy nations cannot achieve. It is hoped that leading political parties will show enough pragmatism to ensure a smooth division of states that will coexist later benefitting each other. ♦



Myths around Hyderabad City busted

The detailed backgrounder prepared by the union home ministry on the bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh has busted many myths and untruths spread by vested interests. One such myth is that Hyderabad accounted for about 60 per cent of the entire revenues of Andhra Pradesh. Those who are opposed to formation of Telangana State have been circulating this false information since a long time. Now, with the union home ministry, which prepared this note based on the information, provided to it by the state finance department, has officially put the breakup of the total revenues like this: Hyderabad city – Rs 20,022 crore, Telangana (excluding Hyderabad) – Rs 41,391 crore, Rayala Seema – Rs 18,215 crore and Andhra – Rs 47, 937 crore.

These figures related to 2012-13 financial year. The total revenues of the state stand at Rs 1,227,866 crore. This note circulated to the GoM on Telangana on the contribution of revenues to the state exchequer by the three regions of the State exposes the falsehood behind the claims of Seemandhra leaders that Hyderabad is the principal contributor to the State economy. Their argument was that this major contribution of Hyderabad was only possible because of the contribution of people of Seemandhra who had settled in the city or had brought their wealth from their districts to the city. Several Seema-Andhra leaders have been talking absolute rubbish stating these absurd figures. In fact, YSR Congress party president YS Jagan

Mohan Reddy and his sister Sharmila campaigned that Seemandhra cannot live without Hyderabad. While others like Chiranjeevi, Pallam Raju, Kavuri Sambasiva Rao, TG Venkatesh, Ganta Srinivas are making foolish statements like Hyderabad should be made Union Territory in view of the financial implica-



tions.

So, even if Hyderabad and rest of Telangana comprising of nine districts put together accounts for Rs 61,413 crore revenues; while Seemandhra regions both combined together sum up to Rs 66,152 crore. That means, Seemandhra will be richer by close to Rs 5,000 crore revenues, compared to Telangana with Hyderabad city. This also proves that the Seemandhra region enjoys a greater financial strength and its contribution to

Hyderabad is not all that significant considering the fact that many others from elsewhere have also been contributing.

So, where is Hyderabad accounting for 60 per cent of the total state revenues? The real figures are also an eye opener to Telangana leaders including ministers, MPs and MLAs, all who had

and got the official information from the State finance department. A lot of valuable time has been wasted and the blatantly wrong information fed by Seemandhra leaders in a high level media propaganda had caused harm to the innocent people in that region.

Here we should not forget the nefarious role played by chief minister Kiran Kumar Reddy. His office has been indulging in systematic leaks of all that information to the media stating that Hyderabad contributed the lion's share of the total revenues of the state. However, it had stated that the revenue earnings were only from revenue earning departments like commercial taxes, excise, transport, stamps and registration, mines, forests, and land revenue.

According to that leaked information, the state's revenue in 2012-13 was Rs 70,548.27 crore with the following break-up: Hyderabad and Ranga Reddy districts contributed the lion's share of Rs 34,100.73 crore whereas Coastal Andhra and Rayalaseema put together contributed Rs 21,538.94 crore. The remaining Rs 13,506.83 crore was contributed by the other districts of Telangana. At least now, the Telangana leaders should thank the union home ministry for reeling out the factual position. The Seemandhra leaders must realize that in the present days, it is very difficult to fudge accounts and fool people. ♦

Chandra Babu, Kiran and Jagan fail to recover from T-shock

As Parliament's winter session scheduled to start on 5th December is fast approaching, politics over demerger of Andhra Pradesh state vis-à-vis Telangana takes a centre stage. Following the second important official meeting of Group of Ministers constituted to work on modalities about bifurcation of Andhra Pradesh for forming new state of Telangana, the political activity in the state and as well as in Delhi once again grabbed all the headlines. The deadline set for eight political parties in the state to submit their opinion/advise on eleven listed issues by GOM on Telangana came to a close; parties in the state pondered over their drafts to be submitted. He talks conveniently about genuineness of Telangana demand while in Telangana and once he sets his foot in Seemandhra talks about the catastrophe of state division. Many are nowadays wondering if the IQ of people like JP Narayan, Kiran Reddy or Lagadapati is all same.

This has certainly exposed all those who are perceived to be opposing Telangana state formation only because of their sectarian interests - But, both TDP, Loksatta doesn't address the eleven issues or other concerns of Seemandhra region either mailing them in writing nor showing any interest to attend the all party meeting which clearly defines their inherited animosity towards T-state formation & it's people's demand of self-rule over it's resources..!? Instead of attending to T-issue; Chandra Babu's TDP, CPM and (Loksatta also) started their manoeuvres for 2014 General Elections as if there is no crisis in their parties & in the state over T state issue..!(The Telangana TDP would stand to loose..?)

On the other hand YSR-CP began distancing itself from GOM & on T state have yet again changed their stance by deciding to send Dr Mysoora Reddy to attend GOM meeting

only to reaffirm their Samaikya Andhra-United stand..? CAKE MIXING

A HARBINGER OF HAPPINESS

Cake is a form of bread or bread-like food. In its modern forms, it is typically a sweet baked dessert. In its oldest forms, cakes were normally fried breads or cheesecakes, and normally had a disk shape. Modern cake, especially layer cakes, normally contain a combination of flour, sugar, eggs, and butter or oil, with some varieties also requiring milk and leavening agents like yeast or baking powder. Flavorful ingredients like fruit purees, nuts, dried or candied fruit, or extracts are often added. Cakes are often filled with fruit preserves or dessert sauces with butter cream or other icings, and decorated with marzipan, piped borders or candied fruit.

The history of the cake-mixing ceremony dates back to the 17th century, when it marked the arrival of the harvest season. During this time lots of fruits and nuts were harvested and prepared to go into the making of the traditional plum cake. The mix was saved up for the next harvest season with the hope that the coming year would bring with it another abundant year.

The first step towards making the cake is the mixing process, formally called the cake-mixing ceremony. It is a ritual religiously followed the world over, and is said to be a harbinger of good tidings and happiness. Stirring ceremony is part of an age-old Christmas tradition of cake mixing and one making wishes for the New Year. The ingredients of the festive fruit cake are mixed with wine and liquor in advance so that the ingredients can develop aroma and taste. Originally a family affair, it is for many years celebrated within organizations to spread camaraderie and goodwill. The sugar content of the liquor and fruit juices help preserve the ingredients.

Also, for the cold "Christmassy weather", the plum cake is a perfect energy food. England loves this cake so much that no tea is complete without a slice of the rich cake. The cake ingredients comprise dry fruits like raisins, black currants, prunes, glazed dates, cherries, candid orange, lemon rinds and nuts like cashews, pistachios and almonds. Large quantities of liquor, fresh juices, honey are generously added to soak all the mixtures. Freshly ground spices are also added and tossed till the fruits and nuts are well coated. This is emptied into large containers and stored for a couple of days before Christmas, with occasional stirring to ensure that the

nuts soak till they are swollen. To get the right flavor it is important to mix the fruits with alcohol atleast 25 days in advance. The correct mix gives the perfect cake and the fun along with it is really awesome. The cake mixing ceremony is also a bonding event for friends, hotel staff and people from different walks of the society. Donning gloves and red aprons, the ritual of pouring and mixing the wine into the chopped fruit is performed with much enthusiasm and gaiety. And the flavor of dry fruits mixing with wine is an experience in itself. Preparation for the Christmas cake begins much in advance.

CAKE MIXING IN ANDHRA PRADESH:

The Westin Hyderabad Mindspace recently organized the traditional cake mixing ceremony in association with Heal a Child and Cheers Foundation. Many leading hotels in Vishakhapatnam also organize Cake Mixing nowadays as a part of the social networking. Heraldng Christmas season traditional cake-mixing ceremony was organized at The Gateway Hotel, Vijayawada.

CHRISTMAS CAKE:

While the cake-mixing ritual has now ac-

quired a social face, it has not diluted its religious importance, and it remains to be one of the most awaited events in Christian household, which marks the onset of Christmas season. A Christmas cake may be light or dark, crumbly-moist to sticky-wet, spongy to heavy, leavened or unleavened, shaped round, square or oblong as whole cakes, fairy cakes, or petit fours, with marzipan, icing, glazing, dusting with icing sugar, or plain. If a Christmas cake is covered in icing, it is quite common for it to be decorated - models of houses, of fir trees or of Santa Claus may be in the array of decorations. The Christmas cake traces its roots to an old English tradition that began as plum porridge.

CHRISTMAS CAKES WORLD OVER:

A particular favourite of many is the traditional Scottish Christmas cake, the Whisky Dundee. As the name implies, the cake originated in Dundee and is made with Scotch whisky. It is a light and crumbly cake, and light on fruit and candied peel only currants, raisins, sultanas and cherries. This Christmas cake is particularly good for people who don't like very rich and moist cakes.

As with all fruitcakes, the almonds or other nuts can be omitted by people who don't like

them or those with severe nut allergies. At the other end of the Christmas cake continuum, the apple creme Christmas cake is a rich mix of finely sliced apples, raisins and other fruit, with eggs, cream cheese, and heavy cream. In the middle of the spectrum is the mincemeat Christmas cake, which is any traditional or vegetarian mincemeat, mixed with flour, eggs, to transform it into a cake batter; or it can also be steamed as a pudding. Coins were also occasionally added to Christmas cakes as well as Christmas puddings as good luck touch pieces. The usual choices were silver 3d piece, or sixpences, sometimes wrapped in greaseproof paper packages.

In Northern England, Christmas cake, as with other types of fruit cake, is often eaten with cheese, such as Wensleydale. A cake that may also be served at Christmas time in the United Kingdom, in addition to the traditional Christmas cake, is the cake known as a "chocolate log".

This is a Swiss roll that is coated in chocolate, resembling a log. In the United States, some people give fruitcakes as gifts at Christmastime, but they are not called Christmas cakes. In the neighboring country of Canada, however, such an item is labelled a Christmas cake, at least among the English-speaking majority. In Japan, Christmas cakes are traditionally

eaten on Christmas Eve. They are simply a sponge cake, frosted with whipped cream, often decorated with strawberries, and usually topped with Christmas chocolates or other seasonal fruit. In the Philippines, Christmas cakes are bright rich yellow pound cakes with macerated nuts or fruitcakes of the British fashion. Both are soaked in copious amounts of brandy or rum mixed with simple syrup of palm sugar and water.

Traditionally, civet musk is added, but rose-water or orange flower water is more common now, as civet musk has become very expensive. These liquor-laden cakes can usually stay fresh for many months provided they are handled properly. In Germany, Stollen, a traditional German fruitcake, is popular. During the Christmas season, it's also called Weihnachtsstollen or Christstollen. In Italy, Panettone, sweet sour-dough bread with a distinct cupola shape, is traditionally eaten at Christmas. It contains raisins and candied citrus fruit and is prepared meticulously over several days. In Cyprus, it is served on Christmas Day. It is the first treat the locals serve to their guests. Cypriot Christmas cake is much like the UK equivalent. Hope this Cake making process for the Christmas will bring peace, prosperity and happiness in every one's life. ♦

How did you take interest in the sport of Polo?

A family friend of ours used to take me on a horse riding in the 'forest areas' of the then 'Banjara Hills' in Hyderabad. I used to be given a ride on the two horses 'Tara' and 'Amber'. I also got an opportunity to ride horses at the Rashtrapati Bhavan in New Delhi.

What about your professional career?

I have worked in many leading companies like Vazir Sultan Tobacco, Nagarjuna Fertilizers, Blue Star and presently Dr Reddys Laboratories. I have also modelled for 'Old Spice' and 'Coca Cola'.

Where does 'Polo' stand in the city of Hyderabad?

Polo was played in Hyderabad from the year 1876. There were nearly seventeen polo grounds in the city of Hyderabad. Slowly all the grounds gave way to commercial buildings and the space for the sport got diminished. Market corrects at all-time levels

The uptrend in the stock market took a short-term halt after crossing the all-time high levels of 21,200. Market sentiment indicator Sensex could not sustain above the crucial psychological mark of 21,000 levels and then slipped into a short-term correction trend. Stocks were seen in a reactionary trend due to profit booking by short-term investors, due to overbought position and also due to purchases slowdown by the foreign institutional investors. American market too is seen in a cautious trend at the current all-time high levels.

Frontline stocks were subject to selling pressure as they have witnessed a strong run-up in the last few weeks. Many mid-cap stocks were seen in losses due to the below expectations financial quarterly results. Bank stocks that have led the earlier market bullish trend were now seen dragging down the market. Some banks have increased the lending interest rates, which can make the retail and corporate loans much costlier.

Software stocks were seen strong due to Dollar's uptrend, while the steel stocks were on the ascend due to strong global trends.

Precious commodity Gold is seen retreating from 31,000 rupees in the commodity market, but is seen sideways in the last few months. Steady buying is seen, but it has to sustain above the 31,000 barrier for a further uptrend. Silver is also seen struck in-between 50,000 and 47000 levels, and only decline below 47000 support,



then it indicates a short-term downtrend.

Crude oil after a continuous declining trend from the high of 7500 rupees in the MCX commodity market, it is seen taking support at 5800 levels, and is now expected to witness a short-term rally for the traders to be cautious.

The Indian rupee has weakened against the American dollar. And is near the five week low. Rupee after a long sideways trend above 61 levels, it has depreciated to 63 mark. In-case of any further weakness, then it could have a negative impact on the market.

Fundamentally for the market to enter into new highs, the forthcoming macro-economic data like the Inflation, GDP, IIP (industrial production), needs to be encouraging. There are still concerns about the slowdown in the economy. The market was seen on the ascending trend by the foreign buying support, in the last few weeks and their activity is now a key factor for determining the market's direction.

Technically, on the charts, Sensex has the next major support below at 20,000 levels, where it has to sustain for keeping immediate uptrend chances safe. But in-case of any further failure at this crucial level, then it indicates a further correction, for the short-term investors to be cautious. ♦
